Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,


we want to invite you to the opening of the exhibition „Parcels for the Promised Land“. This opening will take place on Saturday, 16th of May, between 2 and 8pm in KunstBüroBerlin.

International artists were invited to make parcels (an art work in the size of a shoe-box) as humanitarian aid derived from artistic inspiration, with relevance to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. Art works which deal with frontier regimes, racism migration and isolationism are here of interest. After their exhibition the parcels and art pieces will be auctioned. The entire amount resulting from the auction will be donated to „Save the children e.V“ which aims to support children's rights and to defend them from disease, starving and exploitation. „Save the children e.V.“ is the leading independent organization creating lasting change in the lives of children in more than 120 countries around the world. We are delighted that numerous parcels from all over the world have been submitted to us (Berlin, New York, Moscow, Kiev, Mexico City, Rome, Brussels, etc.).
